Here are the rules:

1. The contest is open to any journalism adviser or instructor who is a member of the WHSSPA. (If you are nominating for Rookie of the Year, it must be the adviser's first or second year as a journalism adviser)
2. The candidate may be nominated by another instructor, administrator, or student.
3. The candidate shall have a significant contribution to the instruction of scholastic journalism in the state of Wyoming during his or her years of teaching/advising, gone beyond expectations, i.e. they basically deserve some recognition. For Rookie of the Year, this may simply mean that they survived the year!
4. A letter of explanation and/or nomination and any appropriate documentation should be sent to:

5. The nomination should be submitted by June 17, 2011
6. The executive committee of the WHSSPA will make the final decision.
7. In place of a cash award and a traveling plaque, the winning adviser will receive a plaque that he/she can display in his/her school.
